Introduction

The latest amendments to the International Arbitration Act (and corresponding amendments to the Arbitration Act) were passed on 9 April 2012. These touch on several important aspects, including: the definition of an arbitration agreement, appeals from a tribunal's negative jurisdictional rulings, emergency arbitrators, enforcement of interim orders and awards on interest. The Singapore Academy of Law has put together a panel representing a cross-section of the arbitration community, including those who have been closely involved with these amendments, to explain and discuss these changes.



CHAIRPERSON

Leng Sun has published widely in international journals and is the author of the book *Singapore Law on Arbitral Awards*, published by Academy Publishing.
